## MSRM DIPLOMA (DCART) Highlights

The Mediterranean Society for Reproductive Medicine (MSRM) announces the launch of its Diploma in clinical assisted reproduction.

The faculty consists of international experts in all aspects of assisted reproduction.

Completion of the Diploma requires the following:

Attending the basic course in assisted reproduction and passing the MCQ examination

Participating in 30 procedures covering all aspects of clinical assisted reproduction in an ART center recognized by MSRM and signing the log book by the center's clinical director

Attending the advanced course in assisted reproduction and passing the MCQ examination

Submitting a review article in an aspect of clinical assisted reproduction assigned by the MSRM examination committee.

The courses will take place during the annual meeting of the Society and the first course will take place in forthcoming meeting of the Society in Crete, Greece in October 2018.

---

### Basic course and MCQ examination

1 DAY | 200 EUR

This will take place in conjunction with any local meeting (2 or 3 times a year with local speakers +/- 1 or 2 MSRM international speakers)

### Training in local center

Observation and/or participation in 30 procedures: monitoring ovulation, oocyte collection, embryo transfers. Log book signed by local MSRM approved expert/trainer

### Essay to be chosen by candidates from a list of subjects

Essays will be collected by the local representative and sent to central office

## PART II

---

### Advanced course and MCQ examination

2 DAYS | 300 EUR

This will take place in conjunction with the yearly MSRM meeting + any other regional meeting (e.g. Crete)
